ATTENTION WEST NILE ALERT

There has been a confirmed Human case of West Nile Virus (mosquito borne illness) in your area of Harrison County.

Please be aware of this and take precautions to protect yourself and your family, and to help reduce the number of cases in the immediate future in your area. Following some of these simple suggestions will help everyone in the community:

- *Limit outdoor activities during early morning hours, late evening, and after dark.
- *If you must be out during these hours, wear light colored long sleeve shirts and long pants.
- *Use screens on open windows and doors.
- *When you are outdoors, use insect repellent containing an EPA registered active ingredient. Follow the directions on the package.
- *Watch and listen to health department alerts and warnings about mosquito disease outbreaks.

We will continue to monitor the situation, spray for adult mosquitoes, and treat standing water that contains mosquito larvae. We will continue trapping and testing mosquitoes throughout the county.
