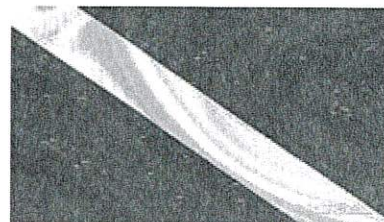
1. Consider rescinding the contract with Mark Blackmer to remove the sunken shrimp boat in the Pass Christian Harbor.

**ORDINANCE NO. 711****AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2, 3 and 8 OF ORDINANCE NO. 694 AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED TO PROVIDE A NEW MINIMUM FEE FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION**

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to increase the solid waste collection rates to provide sufficient revenues for the operation and management of the Combined Water and Sewer Department and for the City to meet its obligations under contract with the Harrison County Utility Authority; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City to increase these rates at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

**I.**

That Sections 2A, 2B, 2D, 3 and 8 of Ordinance No. 471 and 694 and amendments thereto providing minimum fees for the collection of solid waste are hereby repealed and the new minimum rate per customer is increased from \$23.41 to \$26.16 per customer per month, effective October 1, 2025.

**II.**

That all ordinances or parts thereof presently existing, which are inconsistent with this ordinance, are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. That the sections of this Ordinance and the provisions of same are deemed to be separate and independent from each other and if any section, provision, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof shall be held invalid or unconstitutional in any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect or limit the enforcement of this Ordinance.

**III**

Because it is necessary for the preservation of the public health and welfare of the citizens and customers of the City to immediately enact this ordinance to provide sufficient revenues in the next fiscal year to meet the City's contractual and other financial obligations, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect on October 1, 2025.

Nevertheless, this Ordinance shall be enrolled and a summary of same shall be published in the manner required by law.
