TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- No work may begin in the Special Flood Hazard Area until a permit is issued.
- Permit covers all structures and development, including fill, grading, excavation, paving, and any man-made change to improved or unimproved real estate
- If ownership changes before Certificate of Compliance, a new application must be submitted within 15 days; otherwise, all work must cease
- Permit may be revoked for false statements; work must stop until re-issued
- Permit expires if no work is commenced within 180 days
